# Case Study

### Client

The Sikh Gurdwara (Sikh place of worship) in South London caters for a strong Sikh community of 200 – 400 individuals of all ages. With its doors always open to the local community, the Gurdwara has steps up to the front door and an internal lift and staircase inside to take visitors to the first floor worship room. Jasbir Chaggar is the President of the Gurdwara and was concerned to ensure that everyone that wished to, could access the building easily.

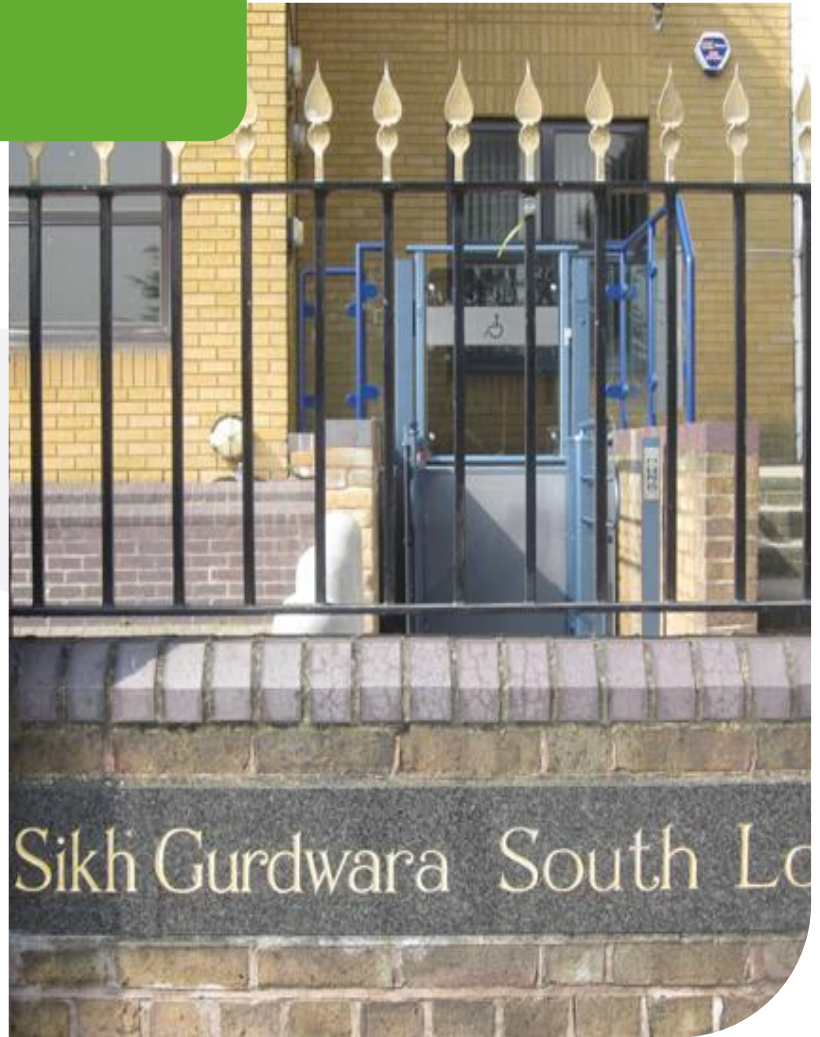
### Problem

With steps to the front door rising to one metre above street level, wheelchair users were not independently able to access the Gurdwara for worship.

### Solution

A self-closing ramp and upper gate and an emergency stop button were also reassuring safety features. Importantly, it also offers overall low maintenance and running costs and can be installed with little or no alteration to the surrounding building. An internal version is also available, as are bespoke finishes.
